Descriptions of camp locations, activities and age groups

Breithaupt Centre -Kids Craft & Games Camp Leader: For kids ages 4 (as of Dec. 31, 2018) – 5 years. Each day includes games, crafts, songs, outdoor activities and a daily swim. Camp leaders are required to participate in the pool activities while lifeguards lead swim activities. Leaders should be excited about crafting, creativity and helping little ones with daily tasks such as tying shoes and opening lunch containers.

Breithaupt Centre -Kids Create & Move Camp Leader: For kids ages 5-6 years. Each day includes games, crafts, songs, outdoor activities and a daily swim. Camp leaders are required to participate in the pool activities while lifeguards lead swim activities. Leaders should be excited about crafting, creativity and helping little ones with daily tasks such as tying shoes and opening lunch containers.

Breithaupt Centre -Kids In Motion Camp Leader: For kids ages 6-7 years. Each day includes a variety of active games, sports, outdoor activities, forest games and swimming. Camp leaders are required to participate in the pool activities while lifeguards lead group water games.

Breithaupt Centre -World Explorers Camp Leader: For kids ages 8-11 years. Help kids discover and appreciate cultures from around the world through their traditions, art, food and games. Also includes daily outdoor activities, forest games and swim time. Camp leaders are required to participate in the pool activities with lifeguards.

Cameron Heights - Kinder camp leader: For kids 4- 6 yrs. old – completed JK – Grade 1. This camp will provide a variety of crafts, games and songs. Children will have the opportunity to use activity centers, quiet time and outdoor activities. There will be 30min daily swim lessons and structured pool activities/games with the lifeguards. Camp leaders are not required to go into the pool as the lifeguards will instruct/supervise this portion of the camp. This time will be leader's lunch or prep time.

Cameron Heights - Kid's adventure camp leader: For kids 7-8 yrs. old, Grade 2 – 3. This camp provides a variety of crafts and games that take place inside and outdoors. There are 2 swim times per day led by lifeguards. Camp leaders are not required to go into the pool as the lifeguards will instruct/supervise this portion of the camp. This time will be leader's lunch or prep time.

Cameron Heights - Swim, Sport, summer camp, camp leader: For kids 8-12 yrs old, Grade 3-7. This active sports camp will give everyone the opportunity to try a variety of sports - indoors, outdoors and in the pool. There will be a variety of active games and activities; accompanied by two swim times in this camp. Camp leaders are not required to go into the pool as the lifeguards will instruct/supervise this portion of the camp. This time will be leader's lunch or prep time.

Grand River Recreation Complex Kids Crafts and Games- Camp Leader: For kids 4 -7 years old. This camp provides children with the opportunity to creatively participate in crafts, in indoor/ outdoor games and activities, and swim lessons. Camp leaders are not required to go into the pool as the lifeguards will instruct/supervise this portion of the camp. This time will be leader's clean up and prep time. Campers must have completed JK prior to camp.

Grand River Recreation Complex Active Kids- Camp Leader: For kids 7 – 10 years old. This camp focuses on the acquisition of sport literacy skills through well planned indoor/ outdoor and pool activities. Camp leaders are not required to go into the pool as the lifeguards will instruct/supervise this portion of the camp. This time will be leader's clean up and prep time.

Neighbourhood Camp Leaders - at City of Kitchener community centres and some schools: For children 4 (as of Dec. 31, 2018) – 12 yrs old. Our program designs include full day options and half day options which run out of community centres and public schools all across the City. Each summer thousands of children join us to participate in their favourite active games and enjoy creative crafts, science activities and outside fun while making friends and enhancing their interpersonal skills. Campers must have completed JK prior to camp.

Budd Park Sports Camp - Leader: For kids 9 to 13 years old. This is a Multi-Sport Camp where participants are taught new sports and get to play some of their favourites as well. Camp leaders know many different sports and enjoy playing sports and teaching sports-related skills. (Campers must be 9 by the end of the calendar year)

Huron Natural Area Eco Discovery Camp- Leader: For kids 9 to 13 yrs old. This camp focuses on exploring the outdoors in forests, wetlands and fields. Camp leaders enjoy the outdoors and outdoor education and will be outside for the duration of the camp day in all weather conditions. (Campers must be 9 by the end of the calendar year)

Rockway Centre – Creative Kids Art Camp Leader: For kids 9 to 13 yrs old. This camp focuses on exploring the arts- music, visual arts, photography and drama. Camp leaders know many different art activities and enjoy creating art and teaching art-related skills. (Campers must be 9 by the end of the calendar year)

Kiwanis Park - Classic Camp Leader: For kids 7 to 12 years old. Campers will spend their days outdoors playing a variety of sports and games, swimming, making friends, and learning about the natural world around them. Campers must have completed Grade 2 prior to camp.
